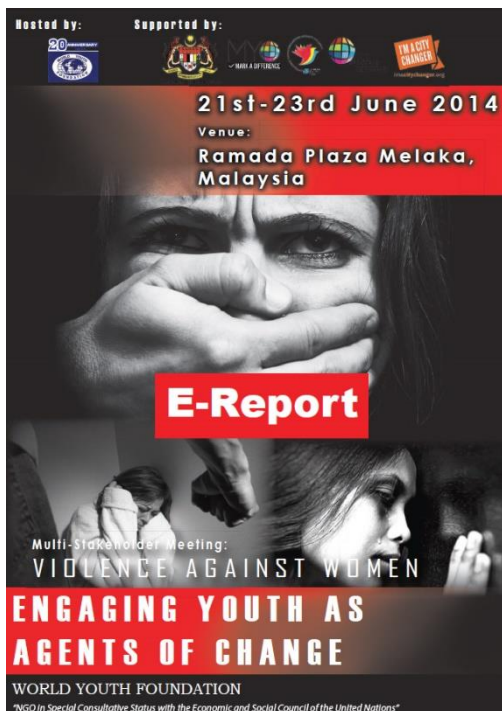

100 RESILIENT CITIES CHALLENGE

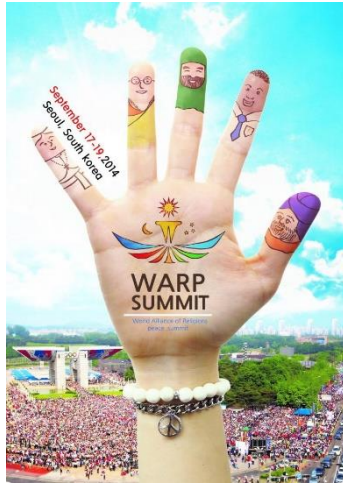

FORESTS ARE KEY TO GLOBAL SUSTAINABILITY

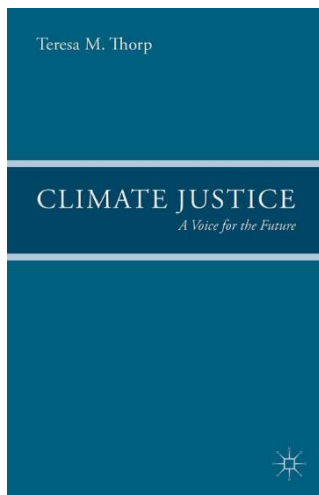

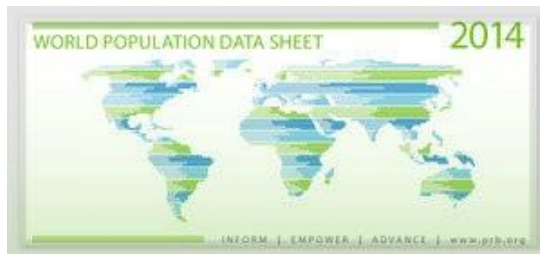
"CLIMATE JUSTICE: A VOICE FOR THE FUTURE"

2014 WORLD POPULATION DATA SHEET NOW ONLINE



Theme for this year: Progress and Challenges. The proportion of people living in poverty has declined, infant mortality has dropped, and fewer mothers are dying in childbirth. But progress has been uneven. This year's data sheet has detailed information on 16 population, health, and environment indicators for more than 200 countries. For three of the indicators, infant mortality, total fertility rate, and life expectancy, we have included data from 1970 and 2013-to show change over time.
