

Group A focuses on prioritising the active involvement of children and youth meaningfully in counteracting Violence Against Women.

To implement the above priority, we recommend the following,

- a. We recognise the importance of Child and Youth participation. And so, we recommend civil society organizations to improve the capacities of youth activists by producing/making accessible the trainers tool keys. At the same time, children and youth can be involved through organising educational events at local authorities.
- b. We recommend the World Youth Foundation to enhance cooperation with local organizations who work with children and youth.
- c. We recommend CSO to support and promote the presence and visibility of active youth individuals in the area of VAW/DV in the local media. Identify success stories. In newsletter, radio.
- d. Recognizing the lack of the voice of victims, we recommend involve social media (short videos. Stories, and so forth).
- e. Recognizing the meaningful role that civil society can play, we recommend the promotion of social responsibilities to respond to domestic violence of local authorities, business and media.
